Have you been diagnosed with or suspected of COVID 19 infection in the last 14 days?		
Have you now or in the last 14 days had any of the following symptoms: cough, sore throat, flu like symptoms, fever, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, loss of sense of taste or smell.?		
In the last 14 days, have you had close contact with a person who is suspected of having or has a confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19?		
Have you been advised by your doctor to self-isolate at any time in the last 14 days?		
Have you been advised by your doctor to cocoon at this time?		

(Close contact: < 2 metres face-to-face contact for greater than 15 minutes.)

Should you answer no to all questions above please bring this form (completed, signed and dated) to your Herbfest registration. You will be declined access to Herbfest 2021 if you do not present this form at registration.

Should you answer yes to any of the questions above you should **not** attend Herbfest 2021. Please seek advice from your medical practitioner.

Please note that should you answer yes to any of the questions above the Herbfest 2021 cancellation policy applies (see terms and conditions).

I confirm that I have answered the above questions to the best of my knowledge.

I understand that there is a risk of contracting COVID 19 infection as a result of attending my Herbfest 2021, through no fault of the Community of Irish Herbalists.
